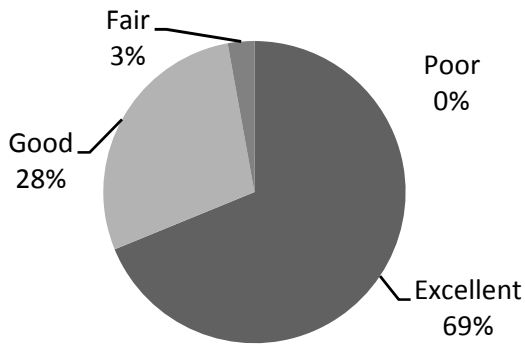

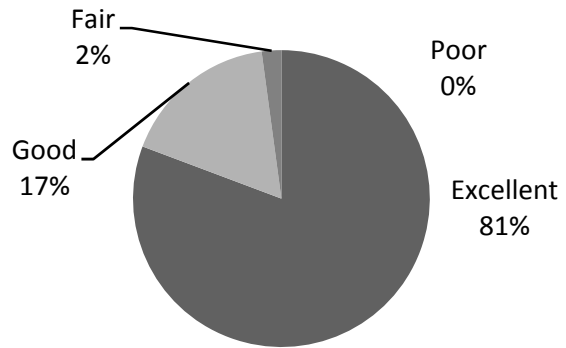

Overall Conference Rating

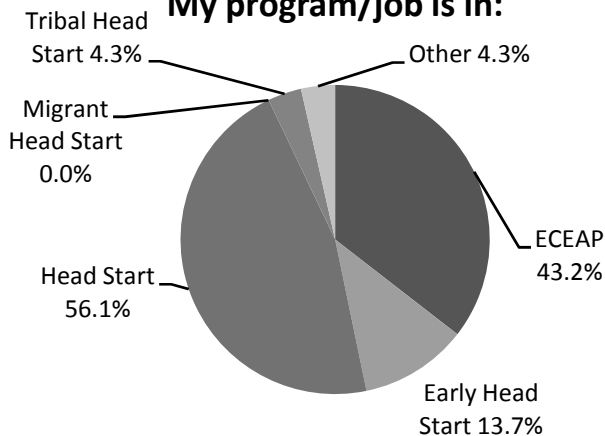


Overall Course Rating



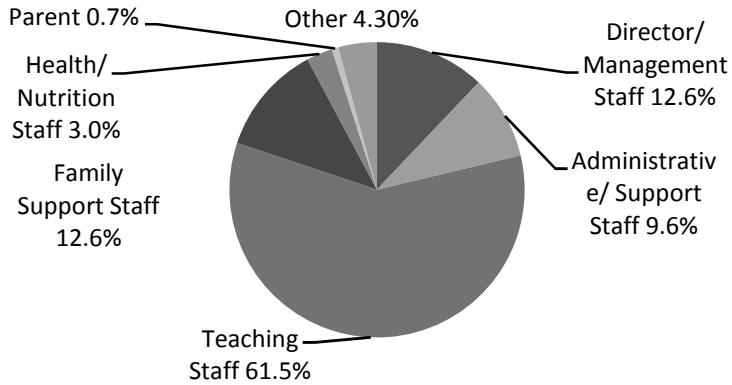

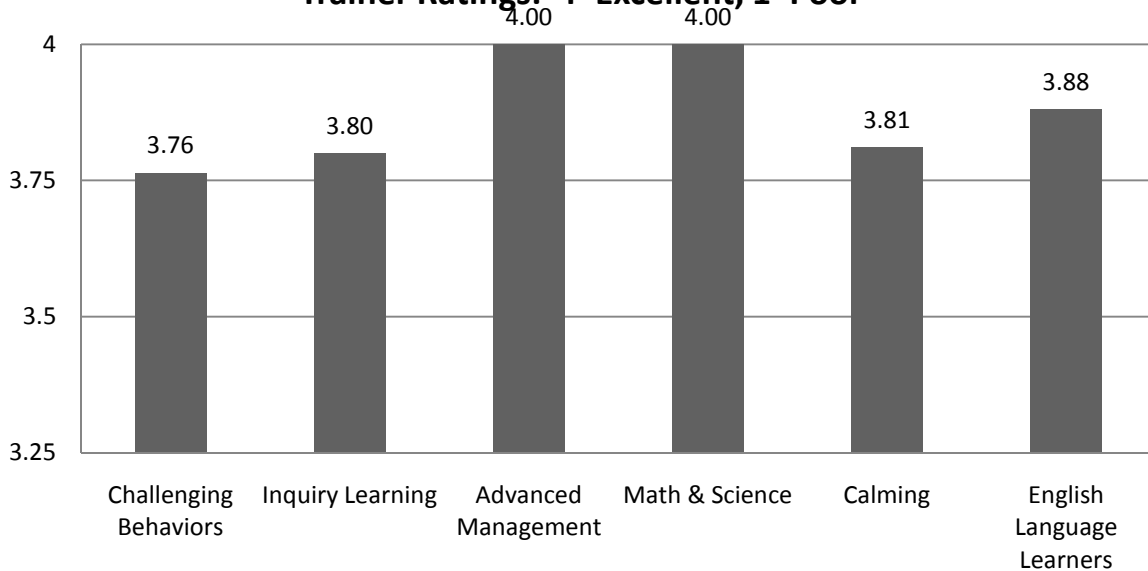

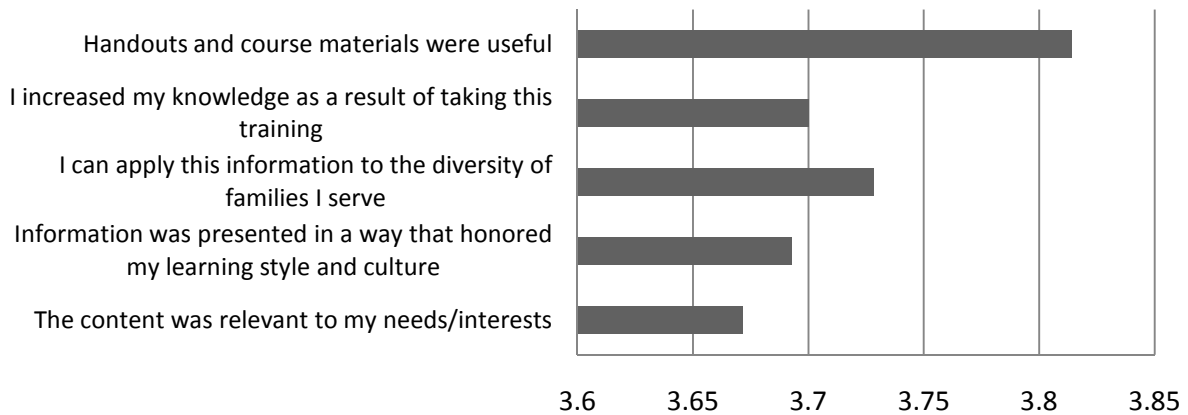

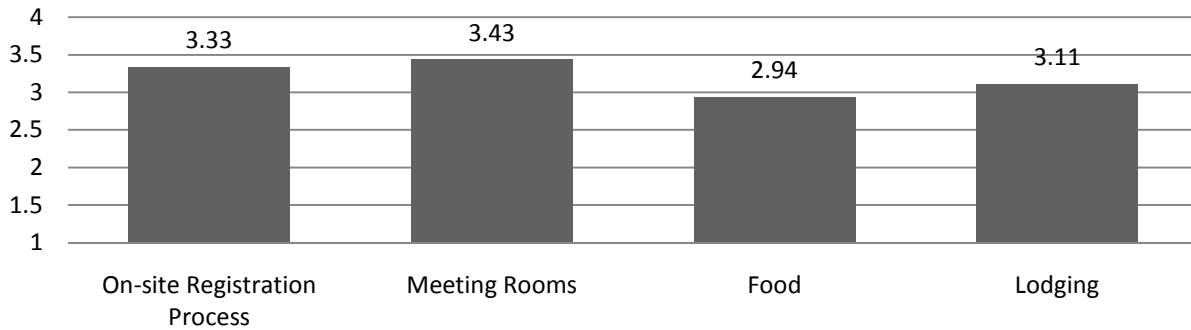

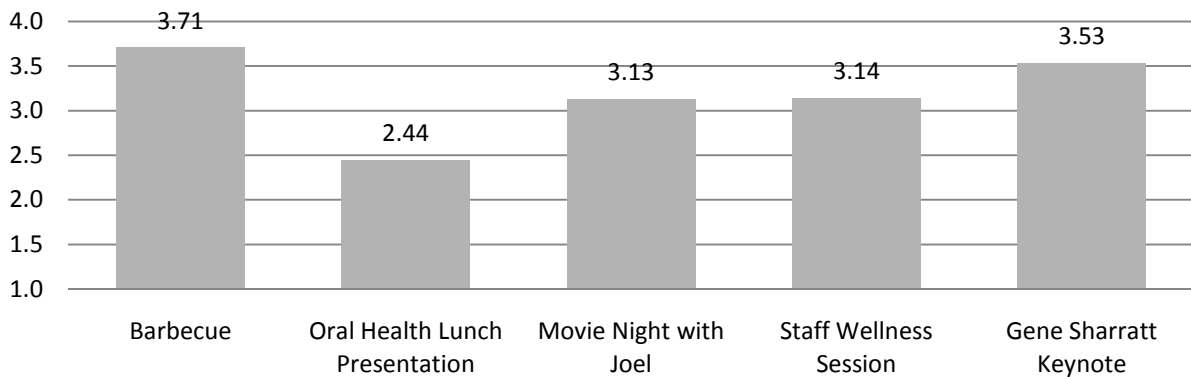
Training Evaluation - 4=strongly agree, 1=strongly disagree



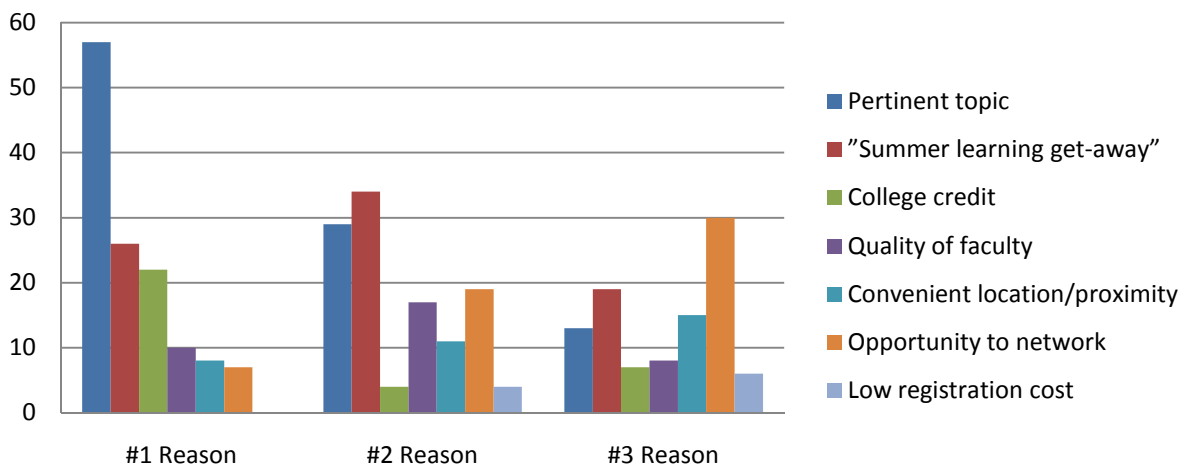
Facility & Registration Ratings: 4=Excellent, 1=Poor



Special Event/Presentation Ratings

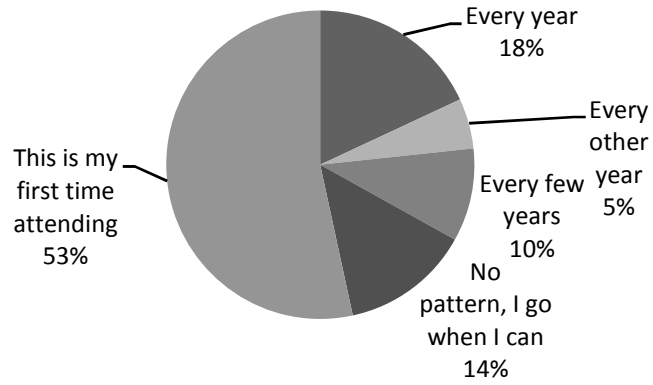

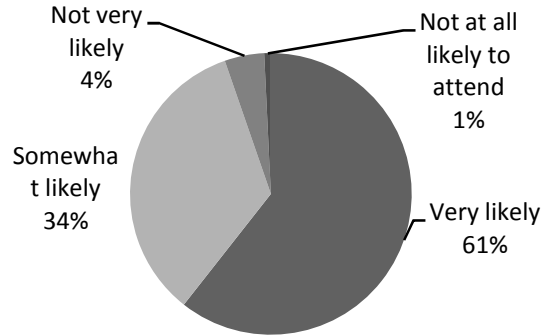
